Reminder of Back-to-School Immunizations

Parkersburg, WV, July 1, 2019 – The Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department (MOVHD) reminds parents and guardians that now is the time to get children vaccinated for Back-To-School. Pre-K, Kindergarten, 7th and 12th grade students must have immunizations and boosters documented before the start of school. The immunization requirements can be found on the MOVHD's website: www.movhd.com.

When scheduling an appointment, please note that if a child is under 18, a parent, legal guardian or an individual with a notarized signature from a parent/legal guardian must be with child before the vaccinations can be given. It is also important to bring proof of insurance if insured. The MOVHD clinic bills most insurances and has a sliding fee scale for those without insurance. To schedule an appointment, call 304-485-7374 ext. 123 or 124 in Wood County. Phone number for Calhoun is 304-354-6101; Pleasants is 304-684-2461; Ritchie is 304-643-2917; Roane is 304-927-1480 and Wirt is 304-275-3131.

There are dental screening requirements for students as well. Pre-K, Kindergarten, 2nd, 7th and 12th grade students must show proof of a dental screening. Dental screenings are available at the MOVHD office in Parkersburg on July 26 and August 9 by appointment only. To schedule an appointment, at 304-485-7374 ext. 106. Limited spaces available.

Students will not be permitted to attend school until immunization and dental records are up to date.
