## For Immediate Release Wood County Resident Dies from COVID-19 in Florida

**Parkersburg, WV April 20, 2020** – The Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department (MOVHD) regret to announce the second death of a Wood County resident. The individual had been travelling and out of West Virginia for three weeks when he passed away.

With 31 positive cases, Wood county ranks 9<sup>th</sup> in the state. Pleasants, Wirt and Roane counties remain at two confirmed cases each. Calhoun and Ritchie have no known positive cases of COVID-19.
