It is important for the public to understand that the demand for testing has increased over the last few weeks. The health department with National Guard support is doing its best to meet the demand by scheduling almost daily testing sites. The lines are long and to process the tests in a timely manner, it is often necessary to stop taking registrations earlier than the scheduled time. Be prepared for a 60 to 90 minute wait.
