MOVHD to host Free Eye Clinic/Low-Cost Glasses

The Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department will host the West Virginia University Eye Institute's Appalachian Vision Outreach Program on Friday, Jan. 26.

The program provides a free eye screening and exam to patients, as well as lower-cost prescription eyeglasses within a tier system, from \$20-50. Glasses must be paid for in cash the day of the exam - no checks or credit cards accepted. There are additional charges for glasses with transition lenses, unlined bifocals, tints, anti-reflective coating, polycarbonate lenses and hi-index lenses.

Appointments for the day will be scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and must be made in advance by calling 304-485-7374.
