Tetanus Clinics for Pleasants, Wood slated

In coordination with the Wood County Emergency Management/Homeland Security and Pleasants County Emergency Management, the Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department will be conducting free tetanus shot clinics in two communities that have been affected by recent flooding.

On Wednesday, April 10, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m., a limited amount of free Tdap (tetanus) vaccines will be offered to households affected by recent flooding for the residents of Pleasants County. The vaccine is suited for those ages 11 years and older. The free vaccines will be given on a first come, first served basis at the Dewey Ave Church of Christ, 701 Dewey Ave, St Marys, WV 26170.

On Friday, April 12, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m., a limited amount of free Tdap (tetanus) vaccines will be offered to households affected by recent flooding for the residents of Wood County. The vaccine is suited for those ages 11 years and older. The free vaccines will be given a on a first come, first served basis at the Old Humphrey School (aka Belleville School), 38 Robinhood Rd., Belleville, WV 26133 (near the intersection of Harris Hwy and Robinhood Rd. and next to the Belleville Church of Christ.)
