 - Health departments across the state received a 2 million dollar decrease. A state funding loss for Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department of \$127,809.98
 - o A special legislative session was called and 5 million was restored to the Department of Health but the line item for the health departments was removed.

o We are currently below funding levels of 2008
